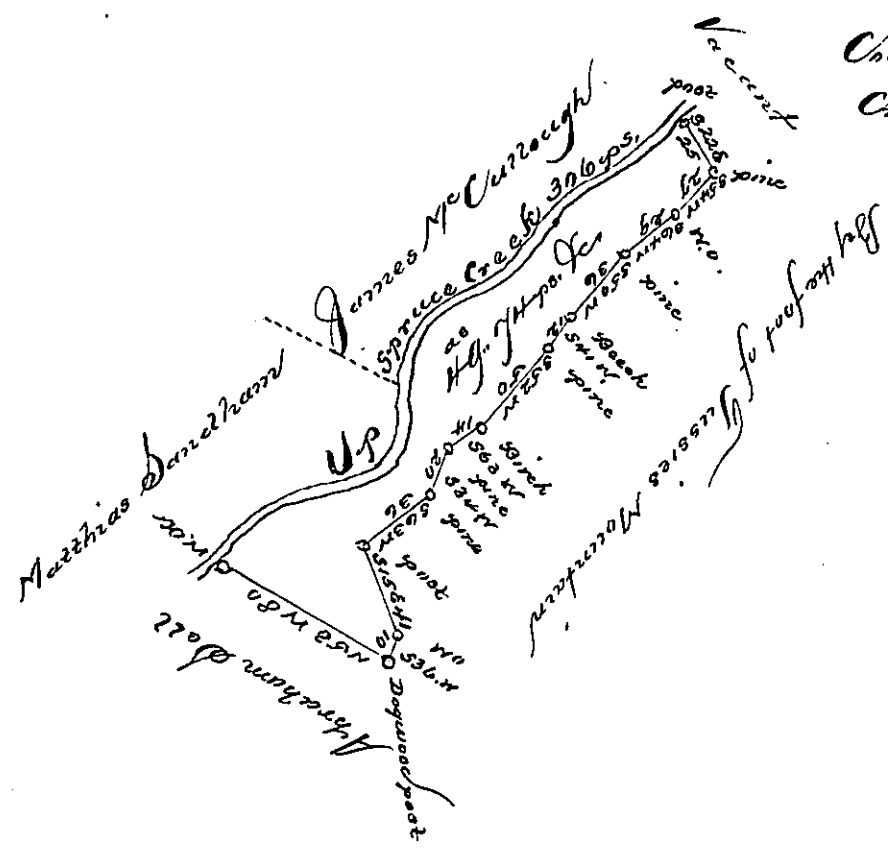

of the Creek in Franklin Township Huntingdon County. Surveyed the 5th  
January 1793 to Joseph Drake, on Warrant dated the 7th May 1792.  
Containing forty nine acres seventy four perches and the allowance of six  
ft. Cent for Roads &c.
