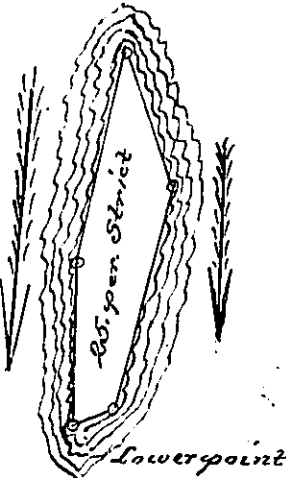


Bag, at Lower Point

Surveyed the 30th June 1816 for Robert Clark the above described
 Island situate in the River Susquehanna in Fairfax Township Dauphin
 County called the "Isle of Mann", opposite land of Marcus Martin on the
 Dauphin Shore and opposite Deercan's Island. Containing twenty five
 perches strict measure by his Warrant dated the 24th day of June 1816.
