



By Virtue of an Application No. 486, dated the 16th August 1765 Surveyed the 25th September 1795 to Nicholas Leiser the above described tract of land Situate on the East Branch of Broadheads Creek about one mile above forks & about several miles from ford Penn in Lower Smithfield Township Northampton, Containing three hundred and fourteen acres & an half and the allowance of six & a Cent & A

The same land is granted to John Towns by Warrant in the name of James Duncan dated 24th October, 1792.
