



Situated on the waters of Dummings Creek, called "Clear Woodland" formerly of Cumberland now Bedford County containing 544 acres & 167 perches with the allowance of six per cent for roads &c. (being one of the tracts within the boundaries of a large Survey made for George Croghan May 22<sup>d</sup> 1766 by Robert McKensie under Richard Ford D.S. Resurveyed August 19<sup>th</sup> 1797. on warrant granted to John Goul Dated June 1st. 1763.
