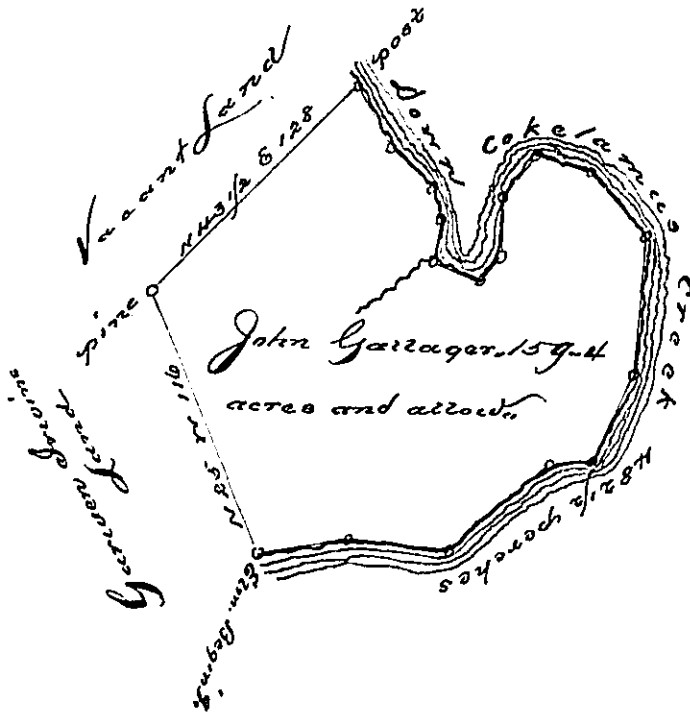

The Draught of a Tract of Land called Situate on Onkelamus Creek in the County of Cumberland Containing one hundred fifty nine acres 60 perches with the usual Allowance of six acres of Cent for Roads. Resurvey'd the 13th day of December Anno Dom: 1769. (agreeable to the lines of a former survey made by Col. John Armstrong) In pursuance of a warrant from the Honble Proprietaries to John Garrager, Bearing date at Philad^a the 8th day of September Anno Dom. 1755.
