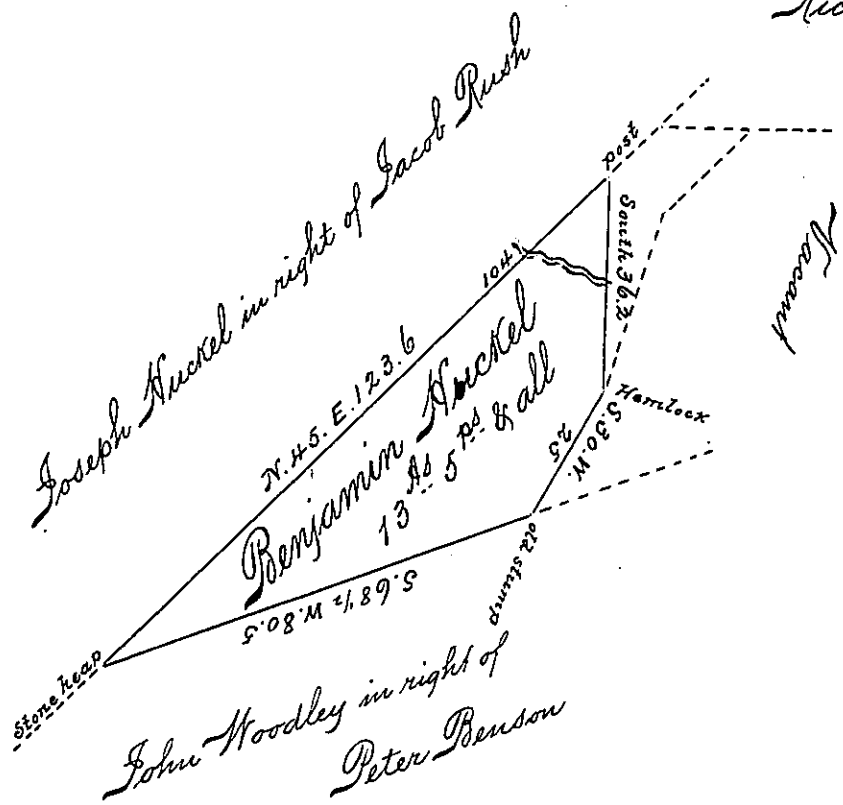


Richard Rogers
