



By Warrant from the Proprietaries Dated y^e 2^a of October Anno Dom 1738 Surveyed to John Gallbreath Jun^r a tract of Land on the Cannon Creek in Donegal Township Lancaster County Beginning at a Black oak a Corner Alexander Dutchessons Land thence North west by North 54 1/2 ps to a post west South west 221 ps to a post then by Land Surveyed for the use of the Proprietors South 31 Deg^s East 214 ps to a post North 54 1/2 Deg^s East 158 ps to a Spanish oak 35 3/4 ps to a post by the Cannon Creek and up the several Courses of the said Creek 95 perches to the place of Beginning Containing Two Hundred & fifty acres of Land by the usual allowance for Roads &c
