



A Draught of a Tract of Land called \_\_\_\_\_ situate on the North or Easterly side of the North East branch of Susquehanna River about two Miles above the Mouth of Dyaloosing Creek in the County of Northumberland adjoining and below land surveyed for Philip Suber containing three hundred & twelve acres & a half besides the usual allowance of 6 Feet for Roads &c. surveyed the 30<sup>th</sup> Day of September 1775 for Christopher Gasselman in Pursuance of an Order Dated the 3<sup>d</sup> Day of April 1769 & numbered 1871.
