



Surveyed to John Richardson on the 11th day of July A.D. 1864 the above described tract of land containing five hundred seventy nine $\frac{4}{100}$ acres and allowance of six per cent for Roads to situate on the waters of Clarion River in Heath & Rock Townships, Jefferson County Pa in the last purchase made of the Indians East of the Allegheny River and Conewango Creek, by warrant of the 24th December A.D. 1793, calling for one thousand acres and numbered 4544. Being part of the same land formerly surveyed to William Willink and others on warrant 98. 2744 dated December 13th A.D. 1792.
