



Whereas on the Appⁿ of Thos^r Howard of the City of Philad^a in behalf of
the Heirs of Wm Beakes of the County of Bucks late Dec^r a Warr^t was granted
bearing date 19th Febr^r 1739 to the Heirs of S^r Beakes, for the Liberty land
appurtenant to his original purchase for 1000^a; shortly after the date of
which W^t a survey was made, by Benj^a Eastburn then Surv^r Genl^r of 20^a of
land in the Liberties, on the west side of Schuylkill, in the Township of
Blockley, as appurtenant to S^r purchase which survey is not now to be found;
therefore on the 9th of Jan^r 1772 I did at the request of Wm Peters Esq^r re-
survey sd tract of land bounded & limited, as above described, —
