

Surveyed for Allen Wilson on the 2nd day of October 1836 the above described tract of Land containing One hundred and nine acres and allowance of six per cent for Roads to be situated on the south side of the Clarion River in the last Purchase made of the Indians East of the Allegheny River and Conawago Creek in Ridgway Township in the County of Jefferson. By Virtue of a Warrant granted to Allen Wilson for 100 as dated at Harrisburgh the 20th day of September A.D. 1836
