



A Draught of seven acres and fifty one perches of land with six per cent for roads situate in Germantown township in Hillshill (formerly Cumberland) county, which is part of a tract of land surveyed in pursuance of an order of survey granted to William Cochran dated 4<sup>th</sup> November 1766. Said to contain 273<sup>a</sup> 76 perches the above part resurveyed 9<sup>th</sup> September 1797. Examined 26<sup>th</sup> January 1811. Note the date of the original survey is not on the original draught altho' it is official and appears very old.
