



A Draught of two hundred and fifty six acres and eighty seven perches of land with six per cent for roads situate in Germanagh Township in Tiffin formerly Cumberland county, which is part of a tract surveyed in pursuance of an order of survey granted to William Cochran dated 1<sup>st</sup> November 1766 and numbered 1805 containing 273 a. 87. Resurveyed 29<sup>th</sup> January 1811. Note, the date of the original survey is not on the original draught, though it is official & appears very old.
