Draught of Land in Swisbott (late Millford) Township, Franklin (formerly Cumberland) County containing Four Acres a Shirty two perches and allowe of 6 perches. It being part of 313 acres and allowe appears to have been surveyed 29<sup>th</sup> September 1794 by virtue an order of Survey to Robert Campbell No. 5219. Dated the 29<sup>th</sup> of October 1766 and resurveyed in part and divide for Cathrine Swiler the 25<sup>th</sup> January 1822.
