



A Draft of one hundred and seventy nine acres & thirty four perches of land with six per cent for roads situate in Turbett Township in Halifax, late Cumberland, county, which appears to have been surveyed originally 16th April 1767 in pursuance of an Order to William Christy dated 22th November 1766 & 1994 said to contain 153^{ac} 14^{pc} Resurveyed 29th October 1803 by William Harris late Deputy Surveyor in pursuance of an Order of the Board of Property, dated 25th August 1803 and said to contain 178^{ac} 14^{pc} with six per cent for road including an addition of 23^{ac} 14^{pc} and resurveyed by Mr. McLean late Deputy Surveyor 11th July 1811 including said addition in pursuance of said order & found to contain 179^{ac} 53^{pc} of land with six per cent, with the following note, "there are about eight acres of the addition cleared fenced and in a state of cultivation in possession of William Wharton assignee of William Christy." as appears from official papers filed in my Office. Examined 9th June 1819.

Note there is a Warrant of 8th May 1819 granted to Catherine Christy for the land called "addition", in the above draft put into my hands
