



An Draught of a Tract of Land Situate in Hereford Township in the County of Berks and State of Pennsylvania Containing Twenty one Acres and 114 Perches of Land and the usual Allowance at Six per Cent for Roads That was Surveyed to David Shultz by virtue of a Warrant granted by the Honble Proprietaries to George Shultz - dated on the 1<sup>st</sup> October anno 1744 - Who by his Deed poll dated on the 16<sup>th</sup> May 1763 sold and Conveyed his Right to the same to the said David Shultz but the Land required by said Warrant was then no more found vacant; the same was by the Secretary ordered to be located to Hereford Township on the 16<sup>th</sup> December anno 1763 - and accordingly Surveyed on the 13<sup>th</sup> August anno 1764. By Order of James Scull, Then Deputy Surveyor for the said County.
