N. B. on this Survey there is about seven acres of land cleared on which
 there is a Cabin in which a family was residing at the time I was on the Survey (December the 11th
 1811) it was first improved in 1794 and is adjoining the other lands of the said Reesal and has been
 Occupied for the last seven years and five years of that time a family has been living on the Survey
 Tho^s Woodside
