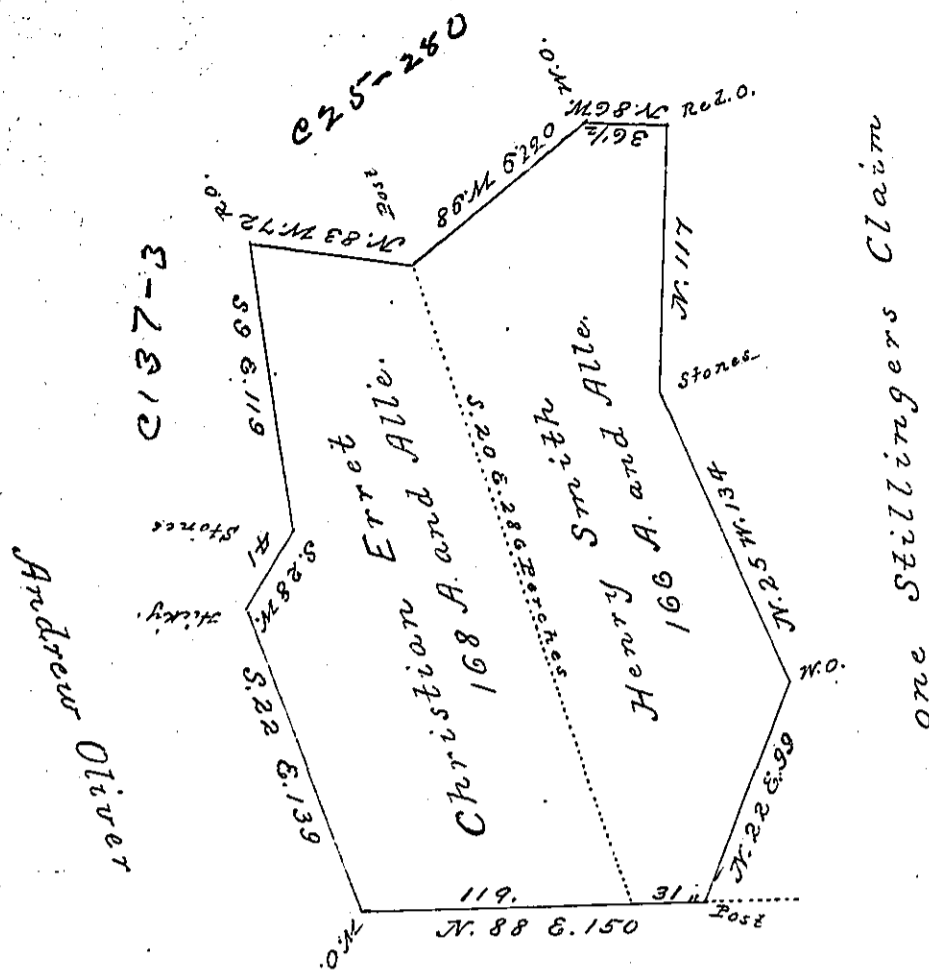


Date of Catherine Millers Warrant Sept 20th 1787.

The above Survey was made for Henry Smith by Captain John Henderson Deputy Surveyor. In Pursuance of a Warrant bearing date Sept. 19th 1785 but not returned, and in the year 1788 I was called upon by Christian Erret to run off 168 Acres of the above Survey, and return the same to the Surveyor Generals Office, as it was the property of a Mr. ~~Henry~~ Henry Smith, the line I run as appears above, and returned the same. Now a Mr. Thos Fisher in behalf of Catherine Miller calls upon me for a Draught of the whole Survey, producing the Warrant. alleging he has the ^{right} property to the land above described the whole survey contains 334 Acres & allowance of six per cent. & a Rough Draught of which was returned to me from Captain Hendersons Office, by Co. Kay, after ^{sa. Hendersons} his decease.

To whom it may concern {September 13th 1790} me Benj. Lodge Depy. S. Y.
 P.S. The Survey which Capt. Henderson made for Henry Smith, was intended to be returned by him, but the return was fraudulently detained by Jno. Hughes Esq: To my knowledge Benj. Lodge
