



Situate in West Township Huntingdon County, east side of Stone-Creek containing Two Hundred eighty four acres sixty nine perches and the usual allowance. Being part of a tract surveyed for Wm Long Jr. the 14th day of June 1787. In pursuance of a Warrant dated November 2nd 1784. Resurveyed in part, and divided; for James Gillam, Nov. 7th 1837. The original survey was said to contain 352 Acs. & 43 Ps.
