



The above is a Draft of a tract of Land Surveyed to William Corbett the 16th day of November 1774 in pursuance of a Warrant bearing date the 25th day of February 1774 By Joshua Elder a former Deputy Surveyor Containing three hundred and twenty nine acres and one half of an acre and Allowance of Six Per Cent. Situate on the Waters of Rocket Creek on a branch thereof, running Southerly (which Rocket Creek is a branch of Cone magh) to include an improvement Standing about one mile from said Creek, in Westmoreland County (now in Armstrong County) Taken from his dra^g now in my possession which I have examined and find Correct, Certified this 18th day of December. 1806
 To Saml Cochran Esq^r S. J. Geo. Ross D.S.

That in Joshua Elder's return he mentions this tract to have been sur^v by Warrant of 25th February 1774 that it has since been returned to Geo. Ingram on Warrant of 17th Dec^r 1784 and that the said tract is settled by Philip Klingelsmith who Claims under Geo. Ingram
