



The above is the draught of a survey on the waters of the South fork of Ten Mile Creek in Green County containing four hundred and sixteen Acres & twenty two perches with the usual allowance of 6. P. Cent &c. It is called Egalite and was surveyed October 31st. 1796 in pursuance of a warrant granted to Alexander Reed October 15th. 1796.
