



A Draught of a Piece of Land Situate in Paradise Township, in the County of York, Containing as above Set forth 40s. & 5. perches & allowance &c. part of 210s. & 143 perches & allowance &c. Which was Originally Surveyed on the 28th day of April A.D. 1836. by William Caldwell late D.S. In pursuance of a Warrant for 30^{as} granted to Abraham Roth, Christian Wiest and Barnet Spangler. In trust for the use of a German Reformed Congregation. bearing date the 15th day of August A.D. 1785. Resurveyed & divided off from said larger tract of land on the 13th day of November A.D. 1837, for and at the request of Henry King, Henry Boose Esq: & John Spangler (of Barnet) Present Trustees of said Congregation, who sold or exchanged the above unto John Roth, who requested me to make return of the same, who wish to Patent &c.
