



Situate Between the Little Crossings & North fork of Turkey foot, in Turkey foot Township Somerset formerly Bedford County & Surveyed the 24<sup>th</sup> day of June 1796 by Alex<sup>r</sup> M<sup>r</sup> Clean Esq. D.S. In pursuance of a Warrant for 150 Acres dated the 5<sup>th</sup> March 1796. But Certified by the Secretary of the Land Office to have been entered for 250 Acres. The Mistake, & Cause whereof is Certified by David Kennedy Esq. the 16<sup>th</sup> day of June 1796. Also Certified by the Surveyor Genl. on the 17<sup>th</sup> day of the same Month, & permission by him given to fill the same agreeably to the description &c. As appears by the Official Draught & endorsement on the Warrant. Certified & Returned the 9<sup>th</sup> day of March 1830.
