Situate on the South Side of Nattingham in the County of Chester & Beginning at a Gum Tree Standing in Nattingham Line Being a Corner of Jacob Job's Land thence West by the s^d. Nattingham Line 285 perches to a Post thence South 14 degrees West by the land of Thomas Chaakly 165 perches to a Post thence East by the Land of Robert Oldham, ^{and J. Cathey} 325 perches to a Black oak thence North 001. the Land of the s^d. Jacob Job 160 perches to the Place of Beginning & Containing 288 Acres with the usual allowance for Roads and High Ways
