



By Virtue of a Warrant dated the 10th July 1784 surveyed the 2th November 1786 to Benjamin Bartholomew the above described tract of land situate on Big pond brook on the Indian path leading from Deely's ferry to the mouth of Leckawassin about two miles and an half from Delaware River in Northampton County containing four hundred and thirty nine Acres three quarters and allowance of six per Cent. &c
