That John Daugherty conducted this survey himself and says it includes the land he intended it for: That J^{no} Mitchell made the survey ~~it is~~ thought & believed that this survey interferes with ^{two} surveys made in the Name of Matthew & Elizabeth Duncan on warrant of the 5th of August 1793 - when on the ground none of the Lines of the surveys of Elizabeth & Matthew Duncan could be found which prevent^{ed} the interference being marked -
