



These may Certifie that by Virtue of an Order from ye Surveyor Genl I surveyd to Richard Webb and Elizabeth his Wife 500 acres of Land with allowance of 6 per Cent as the Law Directs situate in Caln in Chester County.

Beginning at a Corner marked white oak in the line of Joseph Dike thence by the Land of John Hendenhall south 308 1/2 perches to a post thence West by Vacant Land 275 perches to a post thence north by the Land of Anthony Horvix 308 1/2 perches to a post thence East by ye Land of the sd Joseph Dike 275 perches to the place of Beginning, Containing 530 Acres. Surveyd the 5<sup>th</sup> of August 1712
