



These may Certifie that by Virtue of an Order from ye Surveyor Genl I surveyed to Richard Webb and Elizabeth his Wife 500 acres of Land with allowance of 6 per^ct as the Law directs & situate in Caln in Chester County.

Begining at a corner marked white oak in the line of Joseph Pike thence by the Land of John Greenbank south 308 1/2 perches to a post thence West by Vacant Land 275 perches to a post thence North by the Land of Anthony Morris 308 1/2 perches to a post thence East by ye Land of the sd Joseph Pike 275 perches to the place of Beginning containing 530 Acres. Surveyed the 5th of August 1812
