



In pursuance of a warrant for the resurveying of the lands formerly of John, bearing date the 11th day of March 1771 to exclude the land formerly of a certain Tongh Thompson which interfered therewith the above described three tracts of land were resurveyed according to anno 1775 situate on a branch of Pequea Creek in the Counties of Lancaster and Chester that is to say the tracts of 62 $\frac{1}{2}$ ac^s and 11 $\frac{1}{2}$ ac^s 100 $\frac{1}{2}$ ac^s as parts of that tract of 100 $\frac{1}{2}$ ac^s & all granted by Patent of the 5th February 1735 and the above 339 ac^s of allowance as part ~~remaining~~ of that tract of 320 ac^s granted by Patent of ninth day of February in the year aforesaid
