



A Plan of a Lot of Ground situate on the East side of Water Street in the Town of York marked on the General Plan of the said Town Number two hundred and thirty six containing in Breadth on the said Street fifty seven feet and six inches & in length to a twenty feet Alley two hundred and fifty feet Bounded Westward with Water Street aforesaid Northward with a Lot of Ground marked on the said Plan Number two hundred and thirty five Eastward with a Twenty feet Alley and Southward with a Lot of Ground marked on the Plan aforesaid Number two hundred and thirty seven, surveyed for John Beckindorn who has built an House thereon according to the Conditions of settling the said Town.
