



The above is a Draught of a Survey made Jan<sup>st</sup> 20<sup>th</sup> 1785 in pursuance of a War-  
rant granted to Daniel Britt dated Sept 13<sup>th</sup> 1784 Situated on Browns Run a Branch  
of Sennile Creek in Washington County, called Big Spring, containing four hundred  
Acres with allowance of 6 per Cent for Roads.
