


Vacant barren hills and mountains



A Draught of a Tract of Land situate in Townshing Township in the County of Northampton, in the State of Pennsylvania, on the North Side of the Blue Mountains containing Fifty Two Acres and 40 Perches of Land, and the usual allowance at six per Cent for Roads, which was surveyed to John Sheier, by virtue of an Application dated on the 17<sup>th</sup> April Anno. 1767- who by an Assignment of the 30 August Anno. 1784. Sold or Conveyed his Right to the same to Michael Strahl - formerly surveyed by Order of James Scull, Deputy Surveyor, to whom it then returned a Draught for it, but perhaps not yet by him returned into the Surveyor Generals Office - Now drawn for the said Michael Strahl on the 25<sup>th</sup> February. Anno. 1786. -
