



A Draught of a Tract of Land called *Shick-shinning* (which empties into the North East Branch of Susquehanna River between *Winnig Falls* and *Waphallapam* on the Westerly side of said River) and above land surveyed for *John Parkinson* on said Creek in the County of *Northumberland* containing two hundred & ninety eight Acres & a half besides the usual allowance of 6 Cent for Roads &c. surveyed the 25th Day of November 1773 for *John Cox Junr.* In pursuance of a Warrant dated the 7th Day of August 1773.
