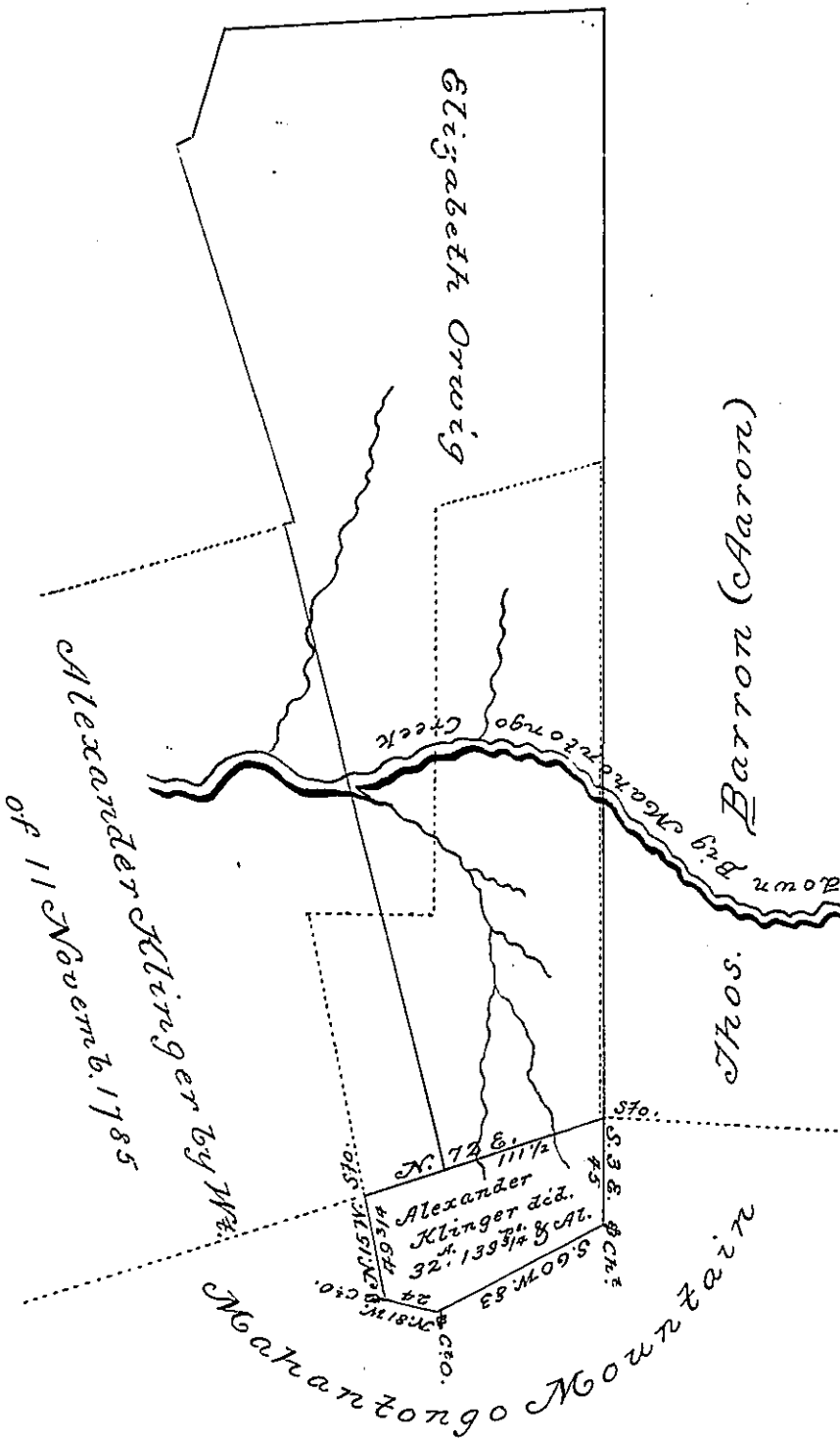

Situate in Upper Mahantongo Township Schuylkill County, Pennsylvania, containing, 32<sup>o</sup> 139<sup>o</sup> 3/4<sup>o</sup> & allowance of six per cent for Roads &c. part of 193<sup>o</sup> 143<sup>o</sup> & allow. which was surveyed to Alexander Klingner, by a Warrant granted to him dated the 7<sup>th</sup> of September, 1792. It being also the remainder of the said W<sup>t</sup>. the major part is covered as above represented by two other Warrants. Alexander Klingner's first W<sup>t</sup>. of the 11. Novemb. 1785, and a Survey made for Elizabeth Orwig, by W<sup>t</sup>. of a younger date, but which now is made good against Klingner's W<sup>t</sup>. of the 7. of Septemb. 1792, by an improvm<sup>t</sup>. continued for upwards of 21 years.
