

By Virtue of a Warrant from the Proprietaries to me Directed Bearing Date ye 8th Day of May 1745 Survey'd to Lilles Goldwell a Tract of Land Situate in New-London Township Chester County Beginning at a Corner White Oak a corner of John Cook's & James Turkes Lands, thence by ye said Cook's ^{Land} South West 44 Pds to a White Oak, & South by West 78 Pds to a White Oak & South 26° Westerly 59 Pds to a Post being also a corner of Thos Mackay's & the said Cook's Lands thence by the Lands of the said John Mackay's & Phineas Hutcheson, South 0° Easterly 138 Pds to a Post, thence by Land 052.061. James Irish South 60° Easterly 53 Pds to a White Oak being a corner of Josias Emmits Land thence by the said Emmits Land North 50° Easterly 107 Pds to a Chestnut & North 27° Easterly 103 Pds to a Black Oak a corner of George Astins & the s^d Emmits Lands, thence North by the s^d Astins Land 22 Pds to a Chestnut, Being a corner of a Maryland Patent Tract no^d belonging to the said Lilles Goldwell thence West by the same 100 Pds to a Hickory & North 160 Pds to a White Oak & East 100 Pds to a Post Standing in y^r off sd Astins line thence North by ye same 61 Pds to a Post standing in James Turkes Line being a corner of the said George Astin Land thence West by the said Turkes Land 83 Pds to the Place of Beginning, Containing 135 acres & ye al- lowance of 6 ac^r Survey'd the 3rd Day of 8th 1747 Per Thos Churchman
