



In pursuance of the Settlement of Joseph Brown commenced about the year 1804, was surveyed on the 21<sup>st</sup> day of October 1837, the above described tract of land situate in Bloomfield township Crawford county 277 Acres 127 perches and allowance of Six per cent for roads &c. (It being the South part, and that part of a larger tract which lies in Crawford county) The west 175 acres 98 perches having been surveyed for Stephen W. Negus, and the East 102 Acres 29 perches for Morrison E. Jones and Elihu Jones, as in the above plot described.
