



Situate in Wharton township Fayette County about 5 or 6 miles above Measons Old Furnace, and including the main forks of Dunbars Run. Surveyed the 28 & 29<sup>th</sup> days of April 1834 In pursuance of a Warrant in the name of said Meason for 400<sup>AS</sup> dated the 28<sup>th</sup> day of December 1793. There was a furnace and sundry cabbins erected for the labourers about the same, upwards of 20 years ago, but they have been abandoned for several years, and are now nearly all decayed & gone
