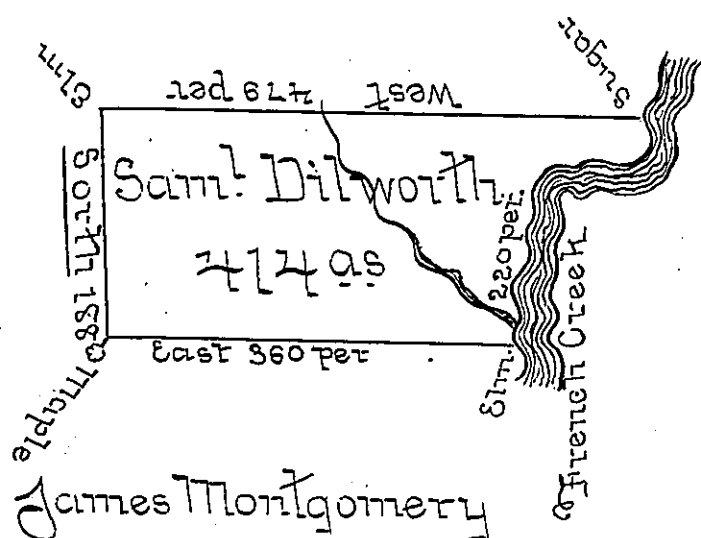


Robert Aitken
