



Situate in the Township of Dublin & County of Huntingdon. Containing one hundred & sixteen acres eighty-four perches and the usual allowance of six per cent for Roads &c. first surveyed the 20th day of Oct^r 1774 in pursuance of an order granted to John Gallagher & James McCallister No. 4744 dated the 4th day of July 1768. it was then said to contain four hundred acres &c. This part resurveyed & divided from the residue of said tract the 15th day of Decr. 1836 the dotted lines representing the original survey
