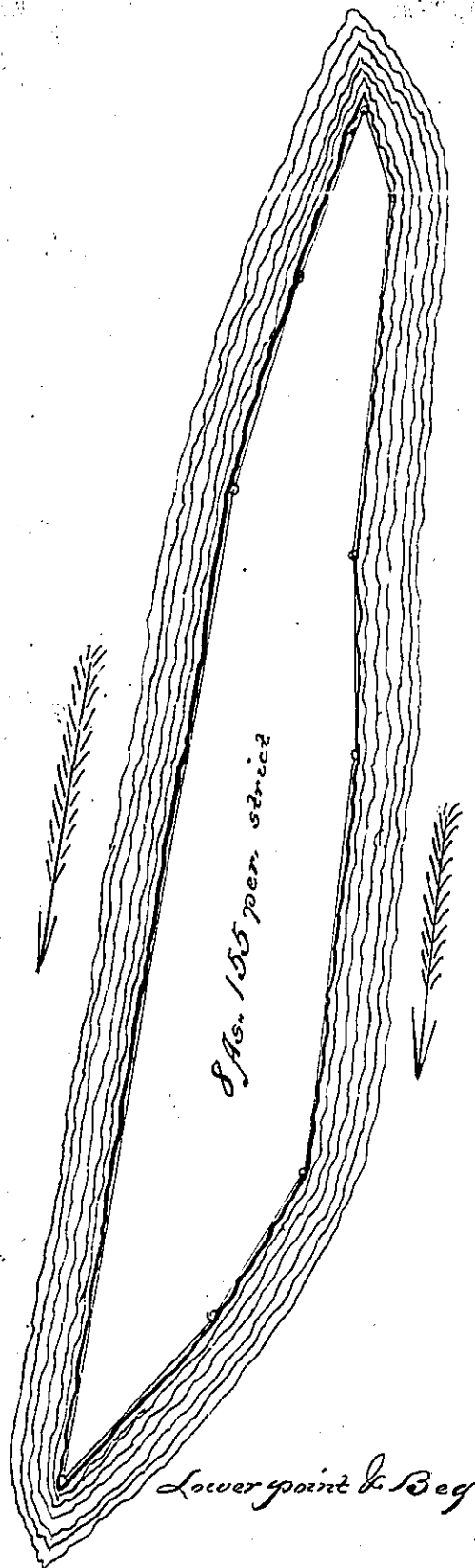

Surveyed the 30th day of June 1816 for Robert Clark the above described
 Island. Situate in the River Susquehanna in Halifax Township Dauphin
 County called Portugal, opposite Duncans Big Island and opposite land
 of Marcus Martin on the Dauphin Shore, and about ten perches distant
 from a smaller Island. Containing eight Acres and one hundred fifty-
 five perches. Strictly measured by his Warrant dated 24th day of June 1816.
