H157 dated 11<sup>th</sup> July 1767 said to contain 305 acres & Resurveyed 13<sup>th</sup> June 1822 for John Thomas the present owner & appears to contain 283 acres 129 perches & the usual allow of six p Cent for Roads &c - doled lines represent a survey made to John Thomas 16<sup>th</sup> May 1794 on his warrant dated 9<sup>th</sup> August 1793 and appears to interfere with Margaret McDonald as above shown; N<sup>o</sup>. containing 116 acres 135 perches & allow is that part of John Thomas lying without Margaret McDonald &c
