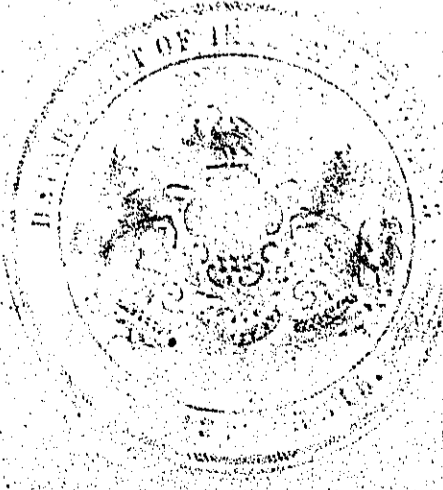
Surveyed to James Stunkard on the first day of June 1816 the above described tract of Four hundred Acres and one hundred and forty four perches and Allowance of six per cent for Roads &c, including an improvement adjoining Greenwald's place (warrantee James Wilson) on the west David Cummins John Wilson and others ^{situate} on both sides of Yellow Creek in Centre Township, Indiana County By Warrant of the 1st January 1816 - as appears from papers remaining in my Office
