



These may Certifie the Surveyor Generall's Office that pursuant to a Warrant under the hands of Edward Shippen Griffith Owen Thomas Story And James Logan the Prop^r And Governour's Commiss^r of Property and y^e seal of y^e Province bearing date the 17th of y^e 10th mo 1701 I Surveyed to George Lee two hundred acres of Land in y^e Manner of Rock Lands in the County of Chester beginning at a Chestnut in Concord Line being also a Corner of Nathi. Newlin's Land thence south 24 deg. East in y^e Line seventy five perches and a half to a White Oak thence West South west 348 perches to a Black Oak in the division Line of y^e Counties thence in y^e Line North 80 deg: West 86 perches to a Post thence North North East 39 perches to a post thence East Nor. East 425 perches to the first mentioned Chestnut. Surveyed Measured and layd out the 23^d of y^e 10th mo. 1701
