



Situate on the Waters of big Sugar Creek Allegheny county containing 1551 acres  
 18 perches and allowance of six per Cent for Roads &c. Resurveyed the 12th of February  
 1799. In pursuance of a Warrant of 400 acres granted William Davison bearing  
 date 30th May 1792. (It being the same tract of Land which was surveyed 22<sup>d</sup> Oc-  
 tober 1795 for John Field in pursuance of his Improvement dated 20<sup>th</sup> October  
 1795)
