 County of Luzerne

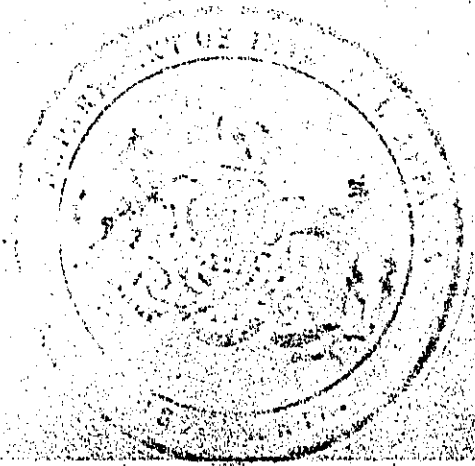
