



A Drought of a Tract of Land Called Stamford situate on the Westerly side of the North East Branch of Susquehanna River on a Brook or Creek called Sugar Creek which empty into said River opposite Wyalosing in the County of Northumberland containing two hundred and fifty four Acres besides the usual allowance of 6 Percent for Roads &c. Surveyed the 14<sup>th</sup> Day of September 1773 for Owen Jones Junr. In Pursuance of a Warrant Dated the 19<sup>th</sup> Day of August 1773.
