erty bearing date the 18th day of September Anno, Dni. ~~1718~~
~~1718~~ for laying out to Isaac Taylor the Quantity of
one hundred acres of Land in the County of Chester in Right
of John Broomal & John Clews who came into this Province
Servants about the year 1682 and by Deeds duly executed

South East by the sd Land 117 Poles to a post Thence East
by North by the Land of the said Isaac Taylor 174 Poles
to the place of Beginning Containing one Hundred ac-
res with the allowance of six acres ^{sd} Roads &
Difference of Surveys -
