



The above Draught describes a Piece of Land originally Surveyd for Nothaniel Porter in Pursuance of a Warrant bearing Date the first of March 1737. The first survey has been since somewhat enlarged by the addition of some small strip of land which was left out of other surveys, & is now the Property of William Gowry situate in Oxford (but formerly Londonderry Township in the County of Chester Surveyd by John Churchman about the year 1738 & Certified the 24th 6^{mo} 1765.
