


No 161. 205 A.S.



Act of General Assembly of the State of Pennsylvania passed the 16<sup>th</sup> day of February 1785, entitled "An Act for directing the mode of distributing the Donations made to the Troops of this Commonwealth"; and by order of the Surveyor General with the approbation of the Honorable the Supreme Executive Council, I have Surveyed on the 31<sup>st</sup> day of October 1785, the above described Tract of two hundred acres of land, and allowance of six per cent for roads, &c.  
No 161 situated in District No. 8. on the West side of the Allegany river, in the County of Westmoreland.
