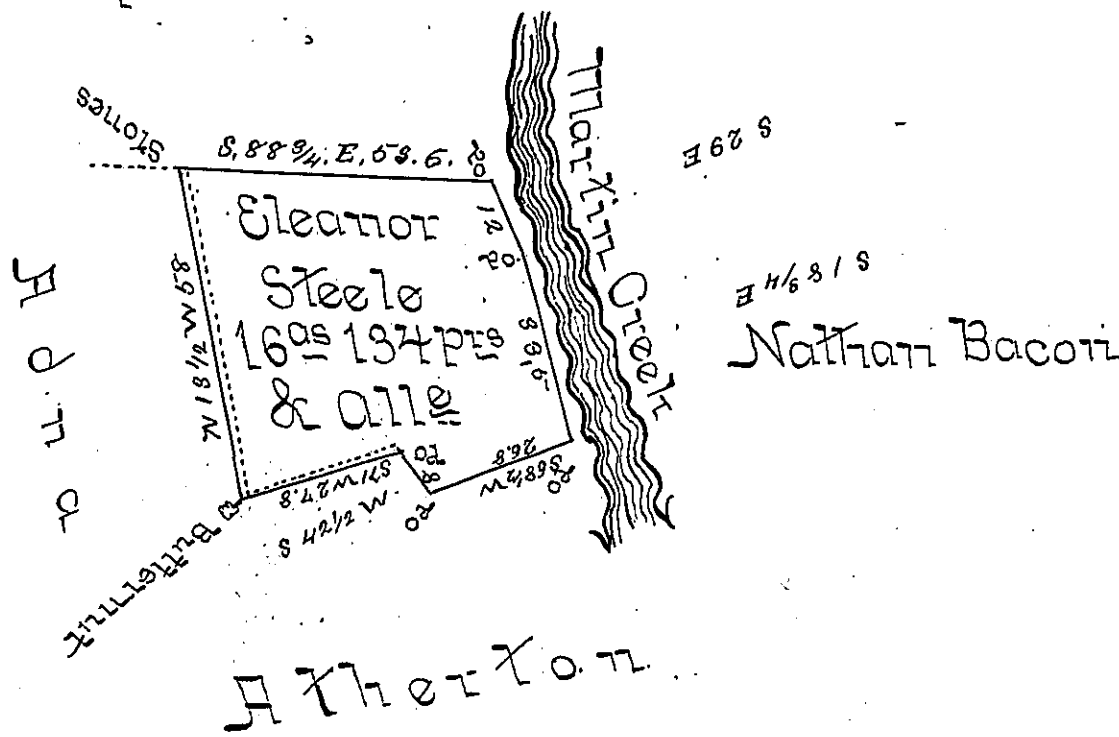


Philip Estes
